## Tips and directions for use

### Before you wash...

**FOR BEST RESULTS**, please clean machine(s) of all residues from other detergents **BEFORE USE**.

- Wash the same load of bath towels (new or old, doesn't matter) three consecutive times. This simulates a month's worth of doing laundry and will remove most residues. (No need to dry the towels in between the three washes.)
- Pre-treat heavy/noticeable stains, as necessary
- Compatible with many builders (sodium carbonate, sodium percarbonate, potassium diphosphate) and disinfectants (chlorine bleach, 3% hydrogen peroxide) and a wide range of temperatures.

**How much Mighty Mike® Liquid Laundry Detergent should you use? Use 1 fl. oz. per Standard Load:**

- **Standard Front and Top Loaders** (large load)
- **HE Front and Top Loaders** (large load): On some front loading HE machines, RV (recreational vehicle) units, or small stack/capacity machines, reduce dose to 3/4 fl. oz.
- **For Super Capacity front loaders** (4.0 ft3 and larger), commercial machines, or laundromat triple-loaders, use 2 fl. oz. See "Exact Dosage Formula" for more....

For "**EXACT DOSAGE FORMULA**" of non-standard sized, average, "large load"

Follow the formula:  **$Dose = 0.5 * X + 0.5$**  Where X= the total pounds of the load divided by 15.

For example:

- A 16 lbs. Load in the washer (~standard load) has X= 1, would equal 1.03 oz of detergent.
- A 45 lbs. Load in the washer (triple loader) has X= 3, would equal 2 oz of detergent.
- A 400 lbs. Load in the washer (holy cow!) has X= 26.66, would equal 13.8 oz of detergent.

**Best care for your specialty and high-tech (high-performance polypropylene, Gore-Tex®, etc.) fabrics:**

- Follow care garment instructions for water temp, agitation, and drying.
- Large spongy/foam materials (such as dive suits, stuffed animals/puppets, certain costumes, etc.) may trap hard to reach bacteria. A second wash may be required or recommended to use a mild disinfectant for odor-laden fabrics.
- Mighty Mike® Liquid Laundry Detergent will rinse completely, so there is no need to worry about residues.

# COMMERCIAL LAUNDRY SERVICES



Before using Mighty Mike® Laundry Detergent in your commercial facilities:

*Please clean your machines of all residues.*

RESIDUE CLEANING PROCEDURE: Put 2 fl. oz. of the Mighty Mike® Liquid Laundry Detergent into the machine with 3-4 towels or some old rags. Run a full cycle with a double rinse. It may take several cycles to remove all previous detergent

residue from clothes.

Always use the full amount of Mighty Mike Laundry Detergent for a load to be effective. Will rinse completely so there is no need to worry about residue. For Super Capacity front loaders (4.0 ft<sup>3</sup> and larger), commercial machines, or laundromat triple-loaders, you may use 2 fl. oz. See "Exact Dosage Formula" for more....

- Wide range of temperature compatibility.
- Compatible with many builders (sodium carbonate, sodium percarbonate, potassium diphosphate) and disinfectants (chlorine bleach, 3% hydrogen peroxide)

*Please put wearable garments new to Mighty Mike through an extra-long cleaning cycle before rinsing them again to remove these possibly irritating residues.*

# CLOTH DIAPER WASHING



Before using Mighty Mike® Laundry Detergent, *please clean your machines of all residues of other detergents before washing your garments in Mighty Mike Laundry Detergent.*

Please follow care instructions on your child's diapers. Remove any large "flushable" waste from fabric before washing. If cloth diapers are new to Mighty Mike, through an extra-long cleaning cycle before rinsing them again to remove these possibly irritating residues.

***It is recommended to use "EXACT DOSAGE" procedure in order to not over or under clean fabrics for sensitive skin!*** See "Exact Dosage Formula" for more....

It is advisable to wash diapers the first time with Mighty Mike® a full 4 or more times before using them on your baby. We want to make sure that nothing but the diaper comes into contact with your baby's skin.

It is recommended to use a mild disinfectant (such as 1/4 cup vinegar (rinse), 1/4 cup hydrogen peroxide (rinse) or 1 tablespoon bleach (wash)) for odor-laden fabrics or disinfect by following the washing process with boiling or sun-drying the fabric.
