PRODUCT COMPOSITION	
Stone Edge Surfaces Deck Seal Tint Pack Colors are 8oz bottles of concentrated natural iron oxide pigments, water and other additives that make them easy to pour and mix with our 5 gallon buckets of Deck Seal deep base waterproofing sealer to create 14 beautiful deck colors. (See Deck Seal Tech Data Sheet for More Info)	
MIXING & USE INSTRUCTIONS	
Application: Stir Deck Seal Well before use. Pour complete contents of 1 - 8oz bottle of Deck Seal Tint Pack Color into 1 - 5 Gallon bucket of Deck Seal deep base Waterproofing Sealer and mix with a mechanical mixer for at least 3 to 5 minutes or until color is uniform throughout with no streaking. Once mixed, Deck Seal is ready for use. See Deck Seal Application Methods.	
PRODUCT USES	
Stone Edge Surfaces Deck Seal Tint Pack Colors are 8oz of concentrated color that must be mixed with a full 5-gallon bucket of Deck Seal deep base. When an 8oz bottle of Deck Seal Tint Pack color is mixed with our Deck Seal deep base waterproofing sealer, the combined colored Deck Seal is used as the Top Coat Waterproofing layer of the Stone Edge Surfaces Deck and Balcony Waterproofing System, and is also used on Concrete and Concrete Overlay walk decks and balconies, as well as Wood Decks.	
PRODUCT CAUTIONS	
Stone Edge Surfaces Deck Seal Tint Pack Colors are NOT meant to be applied as a standalone product and must be mixed with Stone Edge Surfaces Pro Seal deep base to create a colored or tinted waterproofing sealer. Be careful as Deck Seal Tint Pack colors are concentrated pigment stains and any concrete or wood you get them on will stain...protect concrete, wood, stucco etc., that you do not wish to color from spills, splashing, leaking, or accidental transfer from disposing of empty bottles. You must mix the Deck Seal base coat and 8oz bottle of Deck Seal Tint Pack colors for as long as it takes until you no longer see streaks of color in the bucket. This could be 3 to 5 minutes or longer in some cases. The mix ratio is 1 – 8oz Bottle of Deck Seal Tint Pack color to 1 – 5 gallon bucket of Deck Seal deep base. To maintain consistent color, always mix full Tint Pack color bottles with full 5 – gallon buckets of Deck Seal. Do Not Mix partial bottles or buckets Do not apply if rain is expected within 48 hours or if temperatures fall below 50 degrees within 24 hours of application. Please refer to recommended application temperature for Deck Seal.

PRODUCT CLEANABILITY	
When mixed with Deck Seal deep base, the smoother the finished texture, the easier the surface is to clean, but there is a loss of skid resistant properties. Cleaning and disinfecting compounds and cleaning techniques can affect the color, gloss, texture and performance of the product. It is recommended to clean the surface with water only and possibly a “soft” pressure wash. If using cleaning products or light soapy water, test on a non-conspicuous area before use on entire surface.	
PRODUCT COVERAGE & WEIGHT	
Deck Seal Tint Pack 8oz color bottle, when mixed with Deck Seal deep base, will cover approximately 75-100 sqft per gallon with a Weighs of 10.95 lbs per gallon.	
PRODUCT SHELF LIFE	
If properly stored, the expected shelf life can exceed 6 months. However, it is recommended that product be used as soon as possible after delivery. Rotate stock to use oldest inventory first. Store under roof and keep dry.
